Interactive Public Meeting Scheduled for Students and Residents to Provide Testimony on University Tuition Proposals Scheduled

WHAT: The Arizona Board of Regents will conduct a public, interactive meeting to hear testimony and comments from the public, students and other interested parties regarding the level of tuition and mandatory student fees to be charged for resident and nonresident students at Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University and the University of Arizona for academic year 2014-2015. Comments at the tuition hearing will be heard on a first come, first served basis, rotating through participant sites throughout the state.

The Board is expected to set final tuition and fees for the 2014-15 academic year at its April 3, 2014 Board meeting at the University of Arizona. All comments received prior to March 30, 2014 at 5 p.m. will be shared with the regents in advance of the April 3 Board meeting. **The university presidents' tuition proposals will be released on Friday, March 14, 2014.** Links to the proposals will be available at www.azregents.edu.
