Arizona Board of Regents Announce University of Arizona Presidential Search Timeline; Finalist to Visit Tucson Campus

PHOENIX, Ariz. -- The Arizona Board of Regents announced today the timeline for next steps in the search for the next University of Arizona president, including a Tucson campus visit for the finalist.

The board of regents <u>announced</u> two candidates earlier this week for the position. Sethuraman "Panch" Panchanathan, Ph.D., is executive vice president and chief research and innovation officer of Arizona State University's Knowledge Enterprise Development and Robert Clayton Robbins, M.D., is president and chief executive officer of Texas Medical Center.

"This is an important time as we finalize our decision for the next president of the University of Arizona, one of the truly great research and land-grant universities in this nation," said Greg Patterson, Arizona Board of Regents chair. "We look forward to the week ahead as we bring the finalist to the campus to meet with students, faculty and the campus community."
