## **ABOR Tuition Setting Calendar of Events**

Phoenix – Arizona public university presidents will release tuition proposals on Friday for Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University and the University of Arizona. This will be followed by a series of events that will lead to the Arizona Board of Regents voting on tuition and mandatory fees for the 2018-19 academic year.

Key dates in the tuition-setting process are as follows:

At noon on Friday, March 16, the university presidents' tuition proposals will be released. Links to the proposals will be available at www.azregents.edu.

On Tuesday, March 27 from 5-7 p.m., ABOR will host a public hearing for students and the public to comment regarding the tuition proposals. Comments at the tuition hearing will be heard on a first-come, first-served basis at sites throughout the state. Following are the hearing sites:

On Thursday, March 29 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., ABOR will host a tuition workshop where the university presidents will present their proposals. The meeting will be held at the ASU Memorial Union, Turquoise Room and will be live-streamed.

On Thursday, April 5, the board is expected to set final tuition and fees for the 2018-19 academic year. The meeting will be held at the University of Arizona and will be live-streamed.

Public comments on tuition will not be taken at the March 29 or April 5 meetings given that a statewide public hearing will be held on March 27.
