ABOR Tuition Setting Calendar of Events

Phoenix – Following are key dates in tuition setting for Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University and the University of Arizona, including a public hearing and in-depth, tuition workshop that will lead to the Arizona Board of Regents voting on tuition and mandatory fees for the 2020-21 academic year.

At noon on Friday, March 13, the university presidents' tuition and fee proposals will be released. Links to the proposals will be available at https://www.azregents.edu/tuition-setting.

On Tuesday, March 24, from 5-7 p.m., ABOR will host a livestreamed <u>public hearing</u> for students and the <u>public to comment regarding the tuition proposals</u>. Comments at the tuition hearing will be heard on a first-come, first-served basis at sites throughout the state. Following are the hearing sites:

On Thursday, April 2, the board will meet and is expected to set final tuition and fees for the 2020-21 academic year. The meeting will be held at the University of Arizona and will be livestreamed.
