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2021 Tuition Proposals Announced for Arizona's Public Universities

Phoenix, Ariz. – Presidents of Arizona's three public universities released their tuition and mandatory fee proposals for the 2020-21 academic year today. At this time, the board is not increasing resident tuition rates. Proposals include online tuition, non-resident tuition, tuition for the University of Arizona Colleges of Medicine and Veterinary Medicine, and program and class fees.

The next event in the process for setting tuition at Arizona's public universities is a virtual public hearing that the Arizona Board of Regents will hold for students and individuals to comment on the tuition proposals from 3-5 p.m. on Monday, April 27. Instructions on how to comment, including a form to fill out to participate in the public hearing, will be posted at <u>ABOR Live</u>. Comments on tuition proposals may also be submitted electronically to <u>tuition@azregents.edu</u>.

On Thursday, May 7 from 1-4 p.m., the board will hold a virtual meeting and is expected to vote on the tuition proposals. The meeting will be livestreamed and instructions will be available through <u>ABOR Live</u>.

Public comments regarding tuition and fees will not be taken at the board meeting on May 7 given the public hearing that will be held on April 27.
